- 2) Select the Fiscal Year (example here 2023)



3) Type your Organization name (example here **Howard**)



4) Click **SELECT** next to your Organization name (right side)


5) Select the appropriate organization from the popup menu (example here **Howard University**)



- 6) Click submit query
- 7) Review the total Dollar amount (\$10,147,287 in this example)
- 8) Repeat for 2022 and 2021
- 9) To be eligible for this call for proposal, your institution needs to receive an average of less than \$50 million per year total costs of NIH support for the past three fiscal years (2021, 2022, 2023).
