Collections of answers to our most Frequently Asked Questions about the AIM-AHEAD Equity in Population Health AI: Beyond EHR program

Question	Answer
1. Is the training program virtual?	All training offerings will be virtual with the exception of the AIM-AHEAD meeting in the summer of 2025
2. What is the time commitment of the program?	This is a 8-month program requiring approximately 6 hours per week
3. Citizenship/Permanent Resident- does permanent resident meet eligibility criteria?	US citizens, non-citizen nationals, and permanent residents are eligible to apply for this program.
4. I am currently receiving funding from one of the AIM-AHEAD programs. May I apply for this training program as well?	You are encouraged to apply. Please note that if you are an awardee for another AIM-AHEAD program, you will not be eligible to receive a stipend from this training program.
5. I am currently a mentor for a different AIM-AHEAD Program. Am I eligible to apply for this training to improve my skills?	You are encouraged to apply. As an AIM-AHEAD funded researcher, you may not receive a stipend from this training program.
6. Where do I upload letters of support/reference letters?	Reference letters will be submitted by the referring individual; you need to provide the contact information for the referring individual.
7. Can I apply for more than one training program. If so, can I be awarded for more than one training program?	Trainees may apply to multiple AIM-AHEAD training programs and fellowships, but if accepted into more than one, they must select only one AIM-AHEAD training program to participate in per funding cycle.
Can AIM-AHEAD personnel apply for one of the training programs?	AIM-AHEAD-funded Coordinating Center Personnel (MPIs, PIs, Co-Investigators, other personnel) are eligible to apply, but if accepted, they will not receive the stipend and allowance.
